Master a new chord by completing these levels.
Once you have mastered Level 1 you are ready for Level 2.

Level 1

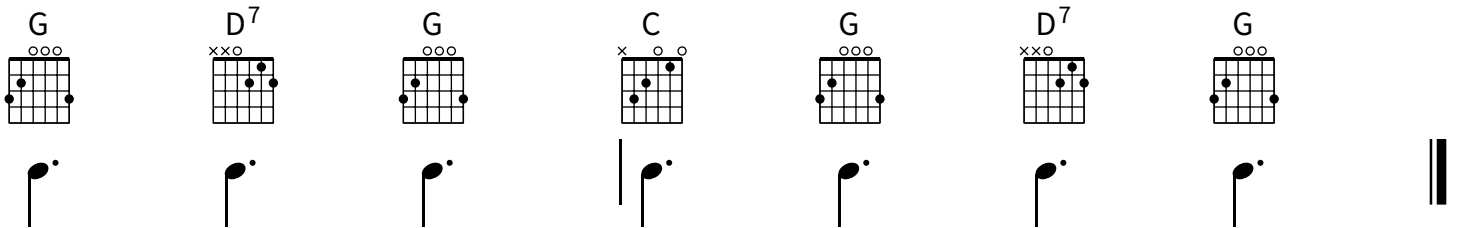
Step 1. Sequential Placement - Place one finger at a time onto the fretboard, make sure to press your weakest to strongest finger onto the fretboard.

Step 2. Shape - When all fingers are pressed on the fretboard you will form a shape.
Take the time to learn the distance from each finger.

Step 3. Release & Press - Release all of your fingers from the fretboard while maintaining the shape of the chord, then press all the fingers onto the fretboard again.

Level 2

Step 1. Full Placement - Create the shape of the chord above the fretboard and press all fingers onto the fretboard.



After mastering level 2 you are ready to work on transitions.

Transitions is when you play one chord after another. Full Placement is required when transitioning.
